The Convenor of the Committee shall verify the application submitted by the respective principal of the affiliated college for grant of affiliation.

The Convenor is also requested to draw TA/DA and sitting charges of the external Members also from the Principal of the constituent Colleges or the Director concerned as the case may be.

In case any one of the Members is not able to attend the meeting, the Convenor can nominate a senior Faculty Member of the College as substitute in consultation with Principal of the respective Constituent College.
